Academy of Model Aeronautics' flying season begins

The 2013 flying season has begun at the Academy of Model Aeronautics' national headquarters in Muncie IN. The facility is on a beautiful, 1,100-acre site, which features flying venues for all forms of aeromodeling.

Several large events are planned that will attract competitors and hobbyists from across the country and around the world. These events include the National Electric Fly-In (NEFI), the Extreme Flight Championships (XFC), the National Aeromodeling Championships (Nats), International Radio Controlled Helicopter Association (IRCHA) Jamboree, the 2013 Indiana Warbird Campaign, and the inaugural National Model Aviation Day celebration. XFC is set for June 14-16. This event brings together the world's best RC model pilots to demonstrate their extreme flying skills in this entertaining competition. This year's event will feature a night-fly with fireworks and a light show performed by modelers. For more information, see www.xfc-rc.com.

NEFI will be held June 21-23. This event will feature model aircraft of all shapes and sizes including micro airplanes, aerobatic aircraft, and large helicopters. A foam-wing Combat contest and Pylon Racing are scheduled, and flight simulators will be available for kids of all ages to try flying. The Nats is a six-week-long competition that will be held June 25 through July 31. Pilots of different skill levels and specialties can register to compete. To see the schedule or register to participate, visit www.modelaircraft.org/nats.

The public is invited to be part of the largest single-venue RC gathering in the world: the IRCHA Jamboree. Scheduled July 31-August 4, this unique event hosts more than 1,000 pilots, several on-site activities, vendors, camping, and more. Additional information can be found at www.ircha.org.

Celebrating its 10th year, the Indiana Warbird Campaign will be held August 29-31. The air show features the best Scale RC airplanes and pilots from across the US and Canada.
